

SAC Meeting- Tuesday, October 6, 2009

Meeting Start Time: 4:15 p.m.

Minutes were reviewed- Mr. Spiegelman approved the minutes, Mrs. Nelson seconded.

Ms. Lopez explained to the group the A+ process and why we are receiving these funds. November 1,2009 is the deadline to agree upon distribution of the funds. After SAC comes up with a proposal, 51% of our staff has to approve it. If it does not pass, another proposal will need to be developed at SAC, and then go to the staff for a vote. Staff votes between the SAC proposal and "None of the Above". Ms. Lopez explained that we have \$ 53,870.00 from the A + money.

A few proposals were discussed with the group.....

Proposal #1

Total: \$53,870

(equal split amongst 2008/2009 employees)

Instructional Staff: 55.5 people @ \$649.00 \$36,019.50

Non-Instructional: 27.5 people @ \$649.00 \$17,847.50

Proposal #2

Total: \$53, 870

Instructional Staff: 55.5 people @ \$750.00 \$41,625.00

Non-Instructional 27.5 people @ \$350.00 \$9, 625.00

All 2009/2010 staff members with teaching certificates can order \$50 worth of items for their classroom:

52 @ \$50.00 \$2,600.00

Proposal #3

Total: \$53,870.00

Instructional Staff 55.5 people @ \$700.00 \$38,850.00

Non-Instructional 27.5 people @ \$546.00 \$15,015.00

This proposal has all money going toward bonus, nothing back to the school.

Mr. Speigelman- recommended proposal #2, the motion was supported. Vote was taken and Proposal 2 passed SAC unanimously. Staff will be told about the proposal at Wednesday's faculty meeting.

Vote will take place on Monday, October 12.

Ms. Gelman-Title I Liaison-Explained that Title I is based on the number of students receiving free or reduced lunch.

- Nova exceeds 40% so we met Title I criteria. We were at 48.6% last year.
