Fifth graders will be getting: Reading, Math and Science

Ms. Gelman-Mash reviewed the SIP Plan for writing-Due to budget cuts only one person will be scoring the FCAT Writing Test as opposed to how it was done in the past.

We are looking for a score of 3 or above
By June 2010 (92%) of the fourth grade students will score 3.0 and above on the Writing FCAT assessment.

*Writing Samples are used once a month and checked by Ms. Dawson for Grades K-2 and Ms. Gelman-Mash reviews grades 3-5.
